Summary of CV

This section describes briefly a summary of your career in science, academic and research; the main scientific and technological achievements and goals in your line of research in the medium -and long- term. It also includes other important aspects or peculiarities.

I am a political sociologist mainly interested in the causes of ethnic and religious hostility. My doctoral research examined the social significance of popular anti-Semitic conspiracy rhetoric in Turkey. The study relied on a historical comparative analysis of the conspiracy theories and in-depth interviews with political party representatives, conspiracy theorists and readers. It received the first prize in the Doctoral Researcher Competition of the Association of British Turkish Academics. I have published the findings in top academic journals, e.g. The British Journal of Sociology, and in edited volumes by leading publishers, e.g. Oxford University Press.

I have a record of success in securing external research grants, which helped me to establish a track record of excellent publications and an international reputation. First, a grant from The Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey allowed me to work on the influence of the internet on the political significance of conspiracy theories in Taiwan. This study was published in Rationality and Society. Second, a grant from the International Centre for the Study of Anti-Semitism enabled me to conduct a qualitative research on online anti-Semitism in Turkey. I published the results in a book by Palgrave MacMillan. Third, I was awarded a Rothschild Foundation postdoctoral grant to conduct a study on the contemporary experience of the Jewish minority in Turkey. In 2011, I won a grant at the Freiburg University to conduct research about Emile Durkheim's influence on Turkish nationalism. I published papers in International Sociology and Journal of Balkan and Near Eastern Studies. Last, I was awarded a research grant of the Gulbenkian Foundation for a study on the perception of Armenians in Turkish politics.

In parallel, I collaborate with colleagues from different disciplines as well as leading research groups. Presently, along with various academics from different fields and countries, I participate in a European Consortium of Research on Conspiracy Theories, Comparative Approaches to Conspiracy Theory. Moreover, I contribute to an ESRC funded research, Understanding Conspiracy Theories, with experts from Political Science, Psychology, and Computer Science. Further, I received John Fell Grant at the University of Oxford in 2015 and worked with three research assistants to explore conspiratorial themes in the Turkish parliament.

I have a viable strategy for future outstanding research that has the potential to result in world-leading publications. With Professor Karen Douglas (University of Kent), Dr Ozan Aksoy (University College London) and Dr Jonathan Bright (University of Oxford), we designed an ambitious five-year research project on the causes and consequences of conspiracy theories. This study will be the most comprehensive and interdisciplinary research in the scholarship that will shape our knowledge about conspiracy theories.



General quality indicators of scientific research

Three main quality indicators of my scientific research are my publications, research grants and awards. To start with, I have published my work in top academic journals in Sociology, Political Science and Area Studies and in a book by Palgrave MacMillan. 10 of the journal articles are published in SSCI journals. I would like to underline that all of these are single-authored works in different journals, which is an indicator of the versatility of my research profile, which ranges from historical sociology to rational choice theory. Second, I have attracted various highly competitive research grants, as you can see below. Third, during my stay at the University of Oxford, I have entered competitions with other postdocs from all social sciences to be offered a research fellowship in colleges. I have been successful with three high-ranking colleges, namely Brasenose, Linacre and St Antony's. My ongoing success in these highly competitive awards can be seen as an indicator of the quality of my research. In addition, my doctoral research received the best research award at the Doctoral Researcher Awards (Social and Management Sciences Category) of the Association of British Turkish Academics.
